## **REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL**

### **ALPENA COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION** **Herron Road Wedge and Overlay.**

Sealed proposals will be received by the Alpena County Road Commission, 1400 North Bagley Street, Alpena, MI 49707, until 1:00 p.m. on Monday June 3, 2024, at which time and place the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud for the application of corrective HMA wedging and overlay on Herron Rd.

Approximately 250 tons of HMA 13A shall be used as needed to restore the crown on Herron Road approximately 3.25 miles north of the intersection of M-32. A 1.5” overlay shall then be applied to ensure an adequate ride quality.

All bidders **must** inspect the existing conditions prior to bidding to familiarize themselves with the necessary means, methods, and materials to provide the requested service. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to determine materials required to provide all such items in their proposal.

Bid packages may be obtained at the Road Commission office at the above address or can be e-mailed upon request by e-mailing [admin@alpcrc.org](mailto:admin@alpcrc.org).

All proposals shall be submitted in sealed envelopes with the name of the bidder, the item bid on, and the date of the bid opening clearly marked on the front of the envelope. No faxed or e-mailed bids will be accepted.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier’s check, bank money order, or bidder’s bond in the amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of the proposal, payable to the Alpena County Road Commission, as a guarantee of good faith. This proposal guarantee shall be forfeited in case of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract and furnish satisfactory bonds, as required, within ten (10) consecutive calendar days after being furnished with the necessary contract and bond forms.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all proposals; to waive irregularities and/or informalities; and to accept, in whole or in part, any proposal which, in the opinion of the Board, is in the best interest of the County of Alpena.
