

ALPENA COUNTY ROAD COMMISSION

POLICY FOR REMOVING ROADS FROM SEASONAL ROAD DESIGNATION

Persons wishing to have a road removed from the Seasonal Road System must submit a written request to the Board of County Road Commissioners for Alpena County. The request should state the reasons and justification for the road to be removed from seasonal designation along with the following:

1. A letter of support from the affected township and commitment for cost share if the township is participating in the cost of improvements.
2. A written statement agreeing to provide a letter of credit or cash deposit adequate to cover the cost of improvements.

The road will be required to be improved so that it is in compliance with the attached Rural Local Road Design Standards, except that the Board will consider waiving the requirement for a plant-mixed asphalt surface on a case-by-case basis.

All costs to improve a seasonal road for reclassification will be at the expense of the party requesting the reclassification.

The Road Commission will hold a public hearing on the requested road change prior to taking any action.

It was further moved that the Rural Local Road Design Standards dated October 24, 2006, be extended to include all rural roads presented to the Board for consideration for acceptance into the Alpena County Road System.
